

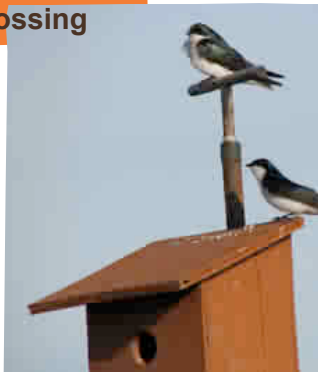
Japanese Gulch Trail and Natural Area

Help us build nesting boxes and install a raptor perch pole.

Driving Directions:
Take the Speedway toward Old Town. Right on 2nd Street. 1st Left, onto Park Ave. Take Park Ave to the very end, then Right onto Mukilteo Lane. Japanese Gulch is just beyond the Railroad Crossing



Join the Student Conservation Association and the Mukilteo Wildlife Habitat Team at Japanese Gulch Trail and Natural Area on July 31, 2010.

At 1pm kids will be building bird boxes (for swallows, chickadees, nuthatches and wrens) and wildlife brush piles, adults will be installing the bird boxes and a raptor perch pole (for eagles, hawks and owls).

At 2pm Community Work Party: Tasks for this week are placing wood chips on the trail and weeding.

Bring your gloves, a shovel and a rake. If you have a wheelbarrow, bring that too.

Drinks and snacks will be provided. As an added bonus you can learn about certifying your home as a wildlife habitat and become part of the Mukilteo Wildlife Habitat Project.
