Snohomish County Rate and Camano Island Assessment Updates

In addition to Kate's discussion of outreach strategies for our 2018 Rates and Charges proposal, Whidbey CD has indicated that they wish to start their renewal process for their next 10 year assessment. This will include a shift to the Rates and Charges methodology utilizing FCS Group. We will cover 25% of the cost of the rate study. The process will occur in 2018 with a 2019 submittal to meet the expiration of December 21, 2019.
