#### WHY THIS ISSUE IS IMPORTANT

Stormwater management in Island County varies by municipality with only the City of Oak harbor subject to NPDES stormwater permit requirements (Western WA Phase II Municipality).



Island County Government, the Town of Langley, and the Town of Coupeville all have some code requiring stormwater management for development activities but none of these municipalities offer stormwater outreach & education, nor do they have formal programs to ensure stormwater facilities are functioning properly, once installed.

Any Island County citizen interested in: consultation of stormwater BMPs on their property; effectiveness training for volunteers to utilize the Rain Garden and Bioretention Protocol; or, contractors that install Stormwater BMPs, please contact us for assistance.
