

SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition

Assistance Program) provides benefits to eligible low-income residents via an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card. This card can be used like a debit card to purchase eligible food at authorized farmers markets.

- » GO to the farmers market Information Booth.
- » **SWIPE** your SNAP/EBT card.
- » RECEIVE tokens to spend with market vendors on SNAP-eligible foods (SNAP tokens do not expire.)



Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is temporary COVID-19 funding available to children who are eligible for free or reduced-price school meals. P-EBT can be used wherever SNAP/EBT is accepted to help families buy food when schools are closed or have reduced in-person attendance.



SNAP Market Match gives shoppers who use SNAP/EBT or P-EBT extra benefits to spend on fruits and vegetables at participating farmers markets.

- » SWIPE your SNAP/EBT or P-EBT card.
- » RECEIVE a \$1 SNAP Market Match for every \$1 in SNAP/EBT or P-EBT, match \$40 or more per day.
- » SPEND SNAP Market Match on fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, mushrooms, seeds, and edible plants.
- » USE SNAP Market Match before 12/31/2021.





WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) is part of the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for lower income Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) improves nutrition for lower income adults over age 60.

- » RECEIVE your WIC FMNP or SFMNP checks.
- » LOOK for farmers displaying signs.
- » SHOP for fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs. Honey is available for senior shoppers only.
- » USE checks before October 31, 2021.

Other Matching Programs

Some farmers markets offer additional benefit or match programs. Check at each market's information booth to see what other benefits programs the market offers.
